As your elected Representative in Hartford, I am honored to serve you in the House of Representatives. The following state funding specific to the 108th District has been awarded since my last district-wide report:

- ★ \$500,000 for the connection of Consolidated and Meeting House Schools to the proposed water system in the New Fairfield town center.
- ★ \$276,025 for construction of road and sidewalk renovations in New Milford's downtown area.
- ★ \$92,000 for renovations to the Historic Swift House in Kent. The facility is one of only two authentic 18th century buildings in town open to the public.
- ★ \$2,500 for for a Veterans Memorial to be constructed in Kent. The memorial will feature names of Kent Veterans who have served in wars from World War II through the present day.

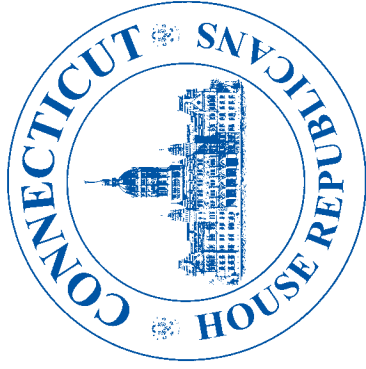
I am currently working with Sherman officials, who are in the process of applying for Small Town Economic Assistance Program (STEAP) funds for the new fiscal year that begins July 1.
