### **Rep. Alberts Votes \$3.5 Million for Eastern CT**



State Rep. Michael Alberts, R-50<sup>th</sup>, Brooklyn, Eastford, Hampton, Pomfret and Woodstock, has voted to authorize about \$3.5 million in funding for northeastern Connecticut programs and projects, under legislation adopted today by the state House and Senate.

The local project funding totals about \$3.5 million and includes:

- Grant-in-aid to the Quinebaug Valley Emergency Communications Center for land acquisition and construction not exceeding \$2,950,000;
- Grant-in-aid to the Quinebaug Shetucket Heritage Corridor, Inc., of Putnam for planning the completion of the Airline Trail not exceeding \$100,000;
- Grant-in-aid to nonprofit organizations including up to \$439,020 to the Windham-Tolland 4-H Camp in Pomfret Center.

Rep. Alberts serves the 50<sup>th</sup> Assembly District of Brooklyn, Eastford, Hampton, Pomfret and Woodstock in the state House of Representatives.
