Suffield's McAnaney appointed to Transportation Commission

Suffield resident Edward McAnaney has been appointed to the Connecticut Public Transportation Commission. Mr. McAnaney was appointed by House Republican

Leader Larry Cafero (R-Norwalk) at the request of state Rep. Ruth Fahrbach (R-Windsor).

The commission is an advisory group of 18 public members and several state agencies. As indicated on the commission's Web site, its function is to advise the Governor, the Commissioner of Transportation, and the Transportation Committee of the General Assembly on issues affecting public transportation. The commission submits an annual report at the end of each year, and conducts monthly meetings as issues arise during the year.

Fahrbach. “Ed has been a fan and frequent user of public transportation and his passion for transportation issues makes him an excellent candidate for this appointment.
