**REP. HETHERINGTON LAUDS HIGH SCHOOL AND TOWN
OFFICIALS FOR ENERGY AWARD**



State Representative John Hetherington, R.-125th, praised New Canaan town and high school officials, including the building committee, on receiving an award of \$287,000 in recognition of energy efficient programs adopted during renovation.

The recognition comes from the Connecticut Energy Efficiency Fund and Connecticut Light and Power Company.

Representative Hetherington particularly hailed H.
