Rep. John Piscopo: Bond Commission approves \$100,000 for Burlington firehouse improvements



At its regular meeting today, the state bond commission approved a grant of \$100,000 for the town of Burlington for firehouse improvements. The grant was advocated for in part by state Rep. John Piscopo (R-Thomaston).
